He met with a serious bike accident, and later, was under going dialysis. He encouraged his family too to joined revolutionary movement and party.

His wife Comrade Bharati Bansode was a State Committee member of CPI(ML) Red Flag and was a state leader of government nursing staff. Comrade Adesh Bansode, State Secretary of MLPI (Red Flag), is his son.
