As Swami Agnivesh (Vepa Shyam Rao; 21 September 1939 – 11 September 2020) passed away yesterday, the nation and its people lost a strong defender of democracy and secularism, bold standard bearer of freedom and egalitarian social life of Indian people and man of piety who empathized and stood with millions fallen into the miseries of poverty, destitution, caste discriminations and all forms of repression.
