APRIL 22 CPI(ML) FORMATION DAY Long Live Marxism Leninism Long Live Indian Revolution

The Communist Party of India (Marxist Leninist) was formed in Calcutta on 22nd April 1969, as part of the struggle against neo - revisionism in the communist movement in India and as the continuation of the Great Naxalbari Struggle. It was the birth centenary of Great Lenin. Formation of CPI (ML) was heralded by a massive rally in Calcutta.

The formation of the CPI(ML) reiterated the importance of the Agrarian Revolution to be the axis and the core content of Indian Revolution, fighting reformist and revisionist deviations of all kinds. Today, due to the imperialist globalisation, the Agrarian crisis has very much sharpened that, crores of peasants are on the path of intense struggle against the anti-peasant pro-corporatisation laws whipped out by the Indian state. The agrarian crisis heavily adds on to the economic, social and the political crises that sharpen due to the intensification of the privatisation of the public sector establishments and the resulting de-industrialisation and the increase in massive unemployment. This has accelerated the objective momentum for the Worker-Peasant alliance that has to be the core class force for the alternative that can salvage the nation.

The Revolutionary Forces in India should grasp this momentum and have to galvanize the essential political streams that represent the interests of the revolutionary classes to materialize the achievement of the alternative.
